

Visiting Professor Program in Philosophy  
Salvador, Bahia, Brazil

Come work with us! The Graduate Program in Philosophy at the Universidade Federal da Bahia (UFBA) is pleased to announce its Visiting Professor Program in Philosophy. Through this Visiting Professor Program, the university seeks to enhance its mission related to the quest for scholarly excellence in a socially inclusive university. Scholars with a Ph.D. degree, seniors or juniors, nationals or foreigners, are eligible to apply to this Visiting Professor Program.

The contract will last at least one year and can be renewed for up to four years. Visiting Professors will receive similar salaries to those received by regular university professors within the following categories (using the Brazilian strata): Adjuncts (U\$ 3,000 per month), Associates (U\$ 4,000 per month), and Full Professors (U\$ 5,000 per month). For Brazilian Visiting Professors, contracts may last for up to one year, renewable for an equal time. For foreigners, contracts may last up to two years, equally renewable.

UFBA is located at Salvador de Bahia. The town was founded in 1549 and was the capital of the colony for two centuries, until it was moved to Rio de Janeiro. It is thus a town with a meaningful colonial heritage. Due to the huge slave traffic in Salvador area, during the long time of slavery in this country, the town is home to vibrant cultural activities with meaningful African influence. Hospitality is a typical feature of Salvador's population, and this hospitality will be surely felt in the work environment by Visiting Professors.

Take note of the necessary documents to the application:

1. A Work Plan for at least one year and up to two years, containing (a) justification, (b) goals, (c) methodological procedures, (d) strategies, (e) research and teaching proposals, (f) expected results and (g) own contribution to the Graduation Program; [aqui eu realmente não entendi - ele quer dizer Undergrad Philosophy Program?]

2. A Letter of Motivation, declaring full acceptance of the terms of the contract and committing oneself to execute the Work Plan;

3. A Research Project;

4. CV
