**Applications for *Visiting Professor Program in Philosophy* at Universidade Federal da  
Bahia, Brazil**

The Graduate Studies Program in Philosophy at Universidade Federal da Bahia (UFBA) is pleased to announce its *Visiting Professor Program in Philosophy*. Through this Visiting Professor Program, the university seeks to enhance its mission related to the quest for scholarly excellence in a socially inclusive university. Scholars with a Ph.D. degree, seniors or juniors, nationals or foreigners, are eligible to apply to this Visiting Professor Program.

Visiting Professors will receive similar salaries to those received by regular university professors within the following categories: Adjuncts (US\$ 3,000 per month), Associates (US\$ 4,000 per month), and Full Professors (US\$ 5,000 per month). The university will provide return air tickets to the accepted applicants. For Brazilian Visiting Professors, contract extensions may last up to one year, renewable for equal time. For foreign Visiting Professor extension may last up to two years, equally renewable.

UFBA was created in 1946 but some of its courses preceded the university. Indeed, some of these courses date from the 19th century, and the first ones were created after the arrival of the Portuguese royal family in 1808, when Brazil was still a colony.

UFBA is located at Salvador de Bahia, with some campuses in the hinterland. The town was founded in 1549 and was the capital of the colony for two centuries, until it was moved to Rio de Janeiro. It is thus a town with a meaningful colonial heritage. Due to the huge slave traffic in Salvador area, during the long time of slavery in this country, the town shows strong cultural activities with meaningful African influence. Hospitality is a typical feature of Salvador's population, and this hospitality will be present while hosting the Visiting Professors.

The applications must be sent until October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to [waldomiro.silva@pq.cnpq.br](mailto:waldomiro.silva@pq.cnpq.br) with a copy to [ppgf@ufba.br](mailto:ppgf@ufba.br), attached with the necessary documents in PDF format.

Take note of the necessary documents to the application:

1. A Work Plan, containing (a) justification, (b) goals, (c) methodological procedures, (d) strategies, (e) research and teaching proposals, (f) expected results and (g) own contribution to the Graduation Program;
2. A Letter of Motivation, declaring full acceptance of the terms of the contract and committing oneself to execute one's Work Plan;
3. A Project of Research;
4. CV
